

Exhibitor Terms & Conditions

Setup

Set up of exhibits will take place from 8:00am to 4:00pm on Wednesday, November 12, 2008. Exhibitor move-in must be completed by 4:00pm. Move-in schedule is subject to change.

To ensure orderly and efficient installation, operation and removal of the displays and to eliminate confusion by the presence or solicitation of unknown or unqualified firms, MGM Grand Detroit (MGM) management will need a list of all General Services Contractors before the start of the tradeshow.

Contractor Service and Information

There will be no on-site contractor services available. All exhibitors are responsible for their own setup and dismantling. Show Management will provide vacuuming of all carpeted areas prior to the start of the show.

Booth Construction and Arrangement

All parts of the display must be finished so as not to be objectionable to other Exhibitors and/or Show Management or such parts will be ordered draped by Show Management and expenses billed to the Exhibitor. Equipment or products exceeding height limitation guidelines may be permitted, on a case by case basis, provided written approval is granted by Show Management. Overhead canopies or simulated ceilings cannot extend out over the front two feet of the booth space. Electrical, pneumatic and hydraulic equipment must meet requirements of electrical, safety and other applicable codes.

Care of Exhibit Space

Show Management will arrange for installation and daily sweeping of aisle carpeting. The Exhibitor shall keep in good order the space occupied by the Exhibitor. The Exhibitor may not place anything in the aisles during open hours of the exhibition. The Exhibitor assumes responsibility of returning the Exhibit space to the Exhibit facility in the condition in which it was found: clean, undamaged and unmarred.

Exhibit Schedule

Employees staffing a booth must have official conference or Exhibit Hall access badges and be properly registered with the conference. The display area will be open to conference attendees ONLY during the published show hours. Registered Exhibitor personnel will have access during non-show hours as announced. Exhibitor personnel MUST be properly registered in order to staff a display and must wear (non-transferable) registration badges during move-in/move-out and Exhibit hours.

Delivery of Equipment

Exhibitors will be responsible for delivery of their own equipment and/or display material to the Exhibit Hall and for removal of equipment and/or display material. The MGM shall control delivery traffic into and out of the Exhibit area to minimize delays. The Exhibitor assumes full responsibility for the delivery of its materials to the space that is assigned. MGM and Show Management assume no responsibility for the performance of services by common carrier, express services, the U.S. mail, telephone and telegraph companies or any other service for which the Exhibitor may contract.

No Flammable Materials

Combustible decorations such as crepe paper, tissue paper, cardboard or corrugated paper shall not be used. Packaging containers, excelsior and wrapping paper are to be removed from the floor and should not be stored under tables or behind displays.

Labor Regulations

The Exhibitor is cautioned that the conditions of union labor vary in each locale and it must inform itself of the particular conditions prevailing in regard to labor transactions at the time it engages any laborer, carpenter, plumber, decorator, etc., or any other person employed for the service of its booth. Labor expenses for each booth (other than what is stated as included) shall be absorbed entirely by the Exhibitor.

Exhibit Inspection

Exhibits will be subject to inspection by Show Management approximately one hour prior to the opening of the Exhibits. Exhibitors found to be in potential violation of the rules will be requested and expected to comply or to dismantle their Exhibit.

Food and Beverage

MGM is the exclusive food and beverage provider for both concessions and catering at the MGM Grand Detroit.

Repair of Damages

The cost of repairing any damage caused by the Exhibitor, its employees, representatives or agents to the property of others and the MGM shall be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. Nothing is to be posted on, tacked, nailed, screwed, or otherwise attached to the columns, walls, floors, ceiling, furniture or property of others or the Exhibit area. If Exhibitor damages the facilities, Exhibitor will pay the MGM the cost of repair or replacement.

Security

General 24-hour access control will be provided by the Show Management for the exhibition including move-in and move-out. Show Management is not responsible for the loss of any material by or for any cause, and urges the Exhibitor to exercise normal precautions to discourage pilferage.

Exhibit Dismantling

Exhibits will close promptly at 4:30 pm, Friday, November 14, 2008. Exhibits must be dismantled/packed for removal no later than 9:00 pm Friday, November 14, 2008. Exhibitor employees must be present for the dismantling and packing of the displays until the booth area is cleared. Show Management is not responsible for items left after the show closes.

Cancellation Policy

A written notice of cancellation is required. Please send cancellation notice to: theSales.NetWork, Inc., 3203 Greenstone way, Oak Hill, Virginia 20171. Cancellations received before November 1, 2008 will be assessed a penalty of 25% of the total exhibitor cost. No refunds for any reason will be made for cancellations received after November 1, 2008.

Indemnification

The Exhibitor assumes the entire responsibility and liability for losses, damages and claims arising out of injury or damage to persons and/or displays, equipment and other property brought by it upon the premises used for the exhibition. The Exhibitor shall indemnify and hold harmless theSales.NetWork, Inc., and MGM, their owners, members, affiliated agents, servants, employees and assigns from any and all loss, damage, claims, actions and suits whatsoever, together with all costs, expenses and attorney's fees in connection therewith, which shall grow out of any injury or death or persons or damage to or destruction of property (tangible or otherwise), caused by, resulting from or otherwise connected with activities of the Exhibitor at the exhibition. Nothing contained herein shall restrict any rights enjoyed by the exhibitor under law.

Compliance With Law

The Exhibitor shall comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and requirements of all federal, state, municipal and local governments, departments, commissions, boards, and officers and shall secure the full compliance therewith from its employees, agents and visitors.

Liability and Insurance

The Exhibitor assumes responsibility for, and hereby releases MGM, Show Management and theSales.NetWork, Inc., and their owners, members, affiliated agents, servants, employees and assigns from any and all liability resulting from, arising out of, or in any way connected with Exhibitors Exhibit or Exhibitor's negligence or intentional acts or omissions at the exhibition (including, but not limited to, installation, operation, use, visitation and removal of the Exhibit or use of the Exhibit Hall).

Exhibitor shall obtain insurance sufficient to cover liability for personal injury and for damage to third-party property resulting from its participation at the exhibition. It shall be the Exhibitor's responsibility to obtain adequate additional insurance for Exhibitor's participation in this event, including but not limited to insurance covering event cancellation and event interruption. Exhibitors assume full responsibility for any damage their Exhibits may cause to the MGM. The obligations set forth in this Section shall survive termination, performance and expiration of the Exhibitor's contract.

Additional Matters: Amendment to Rules

Any and all matters or questions not specifically covered by the preceding TERMS AND CONDITIONS shall be subject solely to the discretion of Show Management. These TERMS AND CONDITIONS may be amended at any time by Show Management with sufficient notice to Exhibitor, and all amendments shall be binding on Exhibitors equally with the foregoing TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

The agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Virginia and all disputes must be settled in Fairfax, Virginia.
